Both our Sunday and all-school masses are well attended and engaging. Our parish has a very involved outreach program and Stephen Ministry. Our students become very involved in service throughout their time here. Currently, we have 85% of our eighth graders signed up for the after school service program (ACTS). Our band and music programs are strong and led by high energy music instructors. This past fall, we hosted the musical, Annie, to an auditorium filled crowd on three different nights. As you can see, we strive to create well-rounded high achieving students.
