

Bad Weather Information: Our Lady of the Visitation follows the Three Rivers School District for closings and delays. Three Rivers will announce a decision on TV and we will also send it through our One Call system. If we have to close when Three Rivers is open, we will use our One Call system. Please make sure your information is up to date by going to our website and click on the One Call Now button.

If the weather turns nasty while we are in school, Three Rivers has been known to close early. If they announce early closings, students who ride the buses will be put on the bus when it arrives. Car-poolers will be dismissed when their carpool arrives, be that at 1:30 or 3:00. If you drive carpool, we ask that you pull in the lot as usual and come to the library where someone will meet you, get the name of your carpool and call the kids to come out and meet you at your car. We will also put it on our OneCall system.

Make plans now with your children for what they should do if there is early dismissal and you are not home. Please do not ask them to call you from school if there is an early dismissal.

TUITION ASSISTANCE & FINANCIAL AID

NEW for 2018-19

Deadline: January 31, 2018 - Please read!

All financial aid or tuition assistance offered to Our Lady of the Visitation students & families must be applied for through FACTS. This includes aid or assistance from the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Catholic Education Foundation (One Faith, One Hope, One Love) as well as assistance from the OLV Education Fund.

To be considered for financial aid for the 2018-19 school year you must apply before January 31, 2018 through FACTS.

Both the Archdiocese and Our Lady of Visitation financial aid programs begin with a single application through FACTS.

No financial aid or assistance will be given without first applying through FACTS prior to January 31, 2018.

This is a change from prior years. In the past families had until May 1, to apply for financial aid.

We have made a significant change to our FACTS application to enable our school families to easily meet the January 31, 2018 deadline.

Previous application years required our school families to supply their most recent tax return. For this application cycle all families will be required to submit their 2016 tax return information.

Our financial aid application will now align with that of the area catholic high schools as well as with the Archdiocese of Cincinnati requirement that the **prior year tax information** be submitted to FACTS.

For example, to apply for financial aid for 2018-19 the parishioner's 2016 tax return information will need to be uploaded to FACTS. Under the old application process OLV would have required that the parishioner's 2017 return be submitted before Our Lady of the Visitation would make a financial aid award. This change will allow all families needing assistance to timely apply for the funds available through the Catholic Education Fund as well as the OLV Education Fund. Application by January 31, 2018 will also allow OLV to award financial aid earlier than June.

Families who do not apply prior to January 31, 2018 will not be eligible to receive financial aid or assistance for the 2018-19 school year.

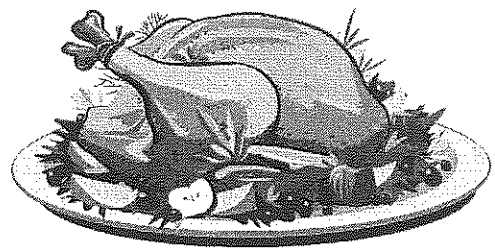
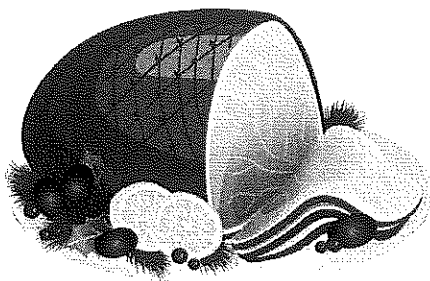
