SVDP AND DIVINE MERCY

* WHY VOTE *

On August 8 there is a special election to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60% of eligible voters on the proposed amendment."

To paraphrase Archbishop Schnurr: a "yes" vote on Issue 1 will make it more difficult to pass any future amendment to the Constitution, including the November ballot initiative that will enshrine abortion without limits*. A "no" vote will make it easier to amend the constitution including the proposed amendment to make abortion legal without limits.

VOTE. HAVE YOUR VOICE HEARD!

*Additional amendment language includes: minor children's access to abortion, sex-change surgery and hormones without parent consent, abortions through all 9 months of pregnancy and removal of safeguards for women's health and safety.


