

OUR PLEDGE TO VISITATION 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

As a valued member of Our Lady of the Visitation Parish, it is important that you and your family participate in the faith life of the parish by worshiping with the Divine Mercy Family of Parishes at weekend and Holy Day Masses throughout the year, volunteer time to Parish ministries, and financially support the Parish on a weekly basis through the offertory.
