## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

There is no need to remove clothing to use your EpiPen, but make sure the orange end will not hit buckles, zips, buttons or thick seams on your clothes.

- 1. **REMOVE THE BLUE SAFETY CAP**. Grasp the EpiPen in your dominant hand and remove the blue safety cap by pulling straight up. Remember, blue to the sky, orange to the thigh!
- 2. **POSITION THE ORANGE TIP.** Hold the EpiPen at 90° approximately 10 cm away, with the orange tip pointing towards your outer thigh.
- 3. **JAB THE ORANGE TIP.** Jab the EpiPen firmly into your outer thigh at a right angle. Hold firmly for 3 seconds, before removing and safely discarding.
- 4. HOLD FOR 3 SECONDS \*Most of the liquid stays in the autoinjector.
- 5. CALL 911 OR CALL FOR HELP



## STUDENT AGREEMENT
