COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

Be sure to check the attached flyer for events and activities students will participate in during Catholic Schools Week that begins on Tuesday 1/30. There are many out of uniform opportunities. During Catholic Schools week, students will have the opportunity to participate in various activities and events

that celebrate the excellence and impact of Catholic schools, including a current family open house on February 1st from 4:15 p.m.-6:00 p.m. where parents can visit their child's classroom and see what they have been up to this year.

Both Aimsweb and MAP assessments have been completed for the Winter benchmark in grades K-8. Next, your child’s teachers and school administrators will attend professional development meetings to better understand how to read the data and use it to make instructional decisions to increase student achievement. Scores will be released mid-February after all professional development is complete.

CATHOLIC EDUCATION FUND SCHOLARSHIPS

This is to clarify some information about the Catholic Education Fund (CEF) Scholarships given by the Archdiocese. Information about these scholarships was sent out last week.

There are three different CEF scholarships.

1. An Elementary Scholarship for Preschool-8th grade students based on financial aid.
2. A Welcome Scholarship for new families to a Catholic School (you have never had a child attend a Catholic School prior).
3. An Employee Scholarship for employees of the Archdiocese.

To apply for the elementary scholarship, **you need to apply through your FACTS account.** By applying to FACTS, you automatically are applying for the elementary CEF scholarship.

To apply for the Welcome or Employee Scholarships, please go to Catholicbestchoice.org >affordability>click on either the Welcome Scholarship or Employee Scholarship Box.

As a reminder, if you receive a full EdChoice Scholarship for your child, that child would not qualify for any of these scholarships. The Elementary Scholarship is based on the financial needs of your family.

The Justin & Rita Weber Family Scholarship was created in memory of the lives of Justin and Rita Weber, founding members of Our Lady of the Visitation Parish and one of the first couples to be married by Father Leonard Vonderbrink, the Parish's first Pastor. Justin and Rita raised ten children, all of whom attended Our Lady of the Visitation School. After grade school the children all attended Catholic high schools. Justin and Rita volunteered many hours of their time to numerous parish and school organizations while raising their family. They raised their family with Christian values and made the necessary sacrifices to assure their children had the benefit of a Catholic education. It is in recognition of these sacrifices that the family of Justin & Rita has established a scholarship to financially assist a Visitation student who desires to continue his or her Catholic education at a local parochial high school.

Award Will Be Given: To one 8th grade student of Our Lady of Visitation School enrolling at a parochial high school in the Cincinnati area.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted by January 26th, 2024.

Criteria: The applicant must graduate from Our Lady of Visitation in spring of 2024 and attend a parochial high school in the Cincinnati area in the fall of 2024. He or she will need to have a grade average for the 7th and 8th grade years of C+ or better. There will be one \$1500 scholarship awarded and credited to the winner's tuition for the 9th grade and sent directly to his/her high school. Completed applications shall be submitted to the OLV school office. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered. As part of the application, applicants shall create and submit a 2 to 3 paragraph essay. The topic of the essay is "**Describe how your practice of the Catholic Faith has been strengthened and influenced by your family**". Applicants may share an experience, tradition, situation or anything that has involved both their family and their faith. It is important that the essay be neat, legible and checked for both grammar and spelling. If the applicant would want to type or print the essay on a separate sheet of paper, that is acceptable. Please place your completed application (unstapled and your name only on the first page) in an envelope clearly marked with "Justin and Rita Weber Family Scholarship Application" and submit it to the school office by January 26th, 2024.

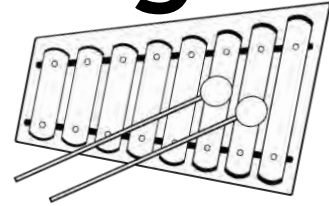

Receive an Ohio Tax Credit!

Catholic School Supporters May Be Eligible for an Ohio Tax Credit!

The State of Ohio has passed a bill that allows a tax credit for qualified donations to a certified Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). Ohio taxpayers who donate to SGOs may be able to claim a dollar-for-dollar, non-refundable tax credit on their state income tax return for up to \$750 per donor (up to \$1,500 if married and filing jointly). *See section 574773 of the Ohio Revised Code.*

The Catholic Education Foundation for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati (CEF) has been certified by Ohio as a scholarship-granting organization (SGO). In keeping with the mission of CEF and the regulations of an SGO, the CEF-SGO will provide scholarships (based on financial need) to students in grades K-12 in the Catholic schools of our Archdiocese.

Your donation can be designated to benefit a specific school(s). Gifts that are not designated to a particular school will be available to families with the greatest need across our Archdiocese.

Consult with your tax advisor to determine: (1) your eligibility for the state tax credit, (2) its value to you, and (3) the details of your gift. **The Ohio budget passed in July added a provision to allow for nonrefundable Ohio tax credits for SGO donations for the 2023 tax year to be made until April 15, 2024. This means that a donor could give to the SGO up to April 15 and still have the tax credit applied to the 2023 tax year. Those tax credits remain at \$750 per individual/\$1,500 for married filing jointly.**

PLEASE NOTE: According to a representative from the Ohio Department of Taxation, if you file a married joint return, each taxpayer would need to make their own \$750 contribution to claim the maximum of \$1,500. Separate acknowledgment letters will be provided for documentation of your gifts.
