COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

Fifth grade students participated in The Jerry Tollifson Art Criticism Open through the Ohio Art Education Association. Each entry will be judged anonymously by volunteers using a scoring rubric. Winning entries will be recognized at the OAEA Youth Art Month Celebration in March in Columbus! Fifth grade students each critiqued one of two art work choices: Our Town, 1995 by Kerry James Marshall or The Steelworker by Kelly and Kyle Phelps. The students had to use their writing skills to describe all elements of the artwork, analyze the emphasis, contrast, movement, balance, pattern or rhythm as well as tell the meaning/theme of the artwork. Lastly, they were asked to evaluate





the art by telling their personal opinion of the art work. Best of luck to our fifth grade students!



Catholic Education Foundation/Archdiocese of Cincinnati

The Catholic Education Foundation funded by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati offers tuition assistance grants. All K-8 grade grants funded by the CEF will be awarded based upon the assessed financial need of our families, performed by a third-party company which will examine a family's income and suggest a level of need. Application is made through FACTS. All schools have been linked to the account of the Archdiocese.

Your application will automatically be reviewed by the Archdiocese as long as your completed application is submitted by the deadline.

Deadline: February 3, 2023

Grant Amount: The grant amount is determined on the number of eligible applications received yearly. The maximum awarded for the 22/23 school year for Visitation was \$1,200 per student.

Annual Applications: These grants must be applied for annually, and will be awarded without distinguishing between families based upon religion.

OLV Financial Aid

Financial Aid is available to qualifying families for the <u>2023-2024</u> school year with documented history of monetary support and participation in the life of the parish. In order to receive Financial Aid a family MUST apply through FACTS. A family will not be considered or awarded aid if an application with FACTS has not been filed or is incomplete.

If a financial crisis occurs during the course of a school year, parents will have an opportunity to request financial assistance by contacting the Business Manager and completing the application process.

The parish cannot meet all the requests for financial aid, but attempts to assist as many families as possible with the resources available.

Reminder: Families applying for aid from OLV need to submit 2021 Tax Returns and W-2's

A financial aid award will not be made until this information is provided. There are no exceptions to this requirement. Families receiving financial assistance are required to be an active parishioner and volunteer at least 20 hours per year. Those not receiving financial assistance are requested to volunteer at least six hours per year.

<u>Who is considered a participating parishioner</u>? It is important to remind our school families that to be considered a *participating parishioner*, eligible to apply for and possibly receive financial aid and receive the parishioner rate for tuition, a parishioner must:

- participate in the faith life of the Parish by regular attendance at Mass
- participate in the community life of the Parish by volunteering time and talents in ministries and organizations as able
- financially support the Parish on a regular, ongoing basis in addition to tuition

Here are high level details of what is required. Please look over this and if you would like more details about the program, please have a member of your family attend this meeting.

- You must be at least 16 years of age to work at Reds games.
- You will be required to attend 5-hour training class at Great American Ball Park before you can work.
- You must commit to working at least 10 games for the season.
- You must be able to work in a concession stand (work on a register, pour beer, grill, setup, cleanup, etc).
- You will be at the ballpark for approximately 7-8 hours, and you will be on your feet this entire time without breaks. Report time is about 3 hours prior to game time, and you must stay until after the game (including rain delays and extra innings)
- A credit will go into your account each time you work, and payments will be mailed to your school/organization once a quarter. The funds raised can be used for tuition, school trips, and other school activities.
- A member of each family looking to join our group must attend this meeting. The representative for your family must be over 18 years of age. ALL minors (16-18) must be accompanied by a parent at this meeting.
