Happy 2023! I wish all of you health, happiness and a closer relationship to God our Savior! Today at mass students saw that there was black cloth draped over the entrances to church in honor of the Pope Emeritus Benedict the XVI. In addition, there was a picture of the former pope on the altar. Two official channels will broadcast the funeral live Jan. 5 (3:30 a.m. EST): the Vatican Media Live YouTube channel (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=INHE3mjiiFw) and

the Vatican News Facebook page (<u>https://www.facebook.com/vaticannews/</u>). Cable TV: EWTN (Eternal Word Television Network) will broadcast the services, beginning at 3 a.m. leading up to the 3:30 a.m. funeral. The network also will broadcast encore presentations of the funeral Jan. 5 at 3 p.m. and 9 p.m. for those unable to watch the live broadcast.

While setting your New Year's Resolution, don't forget to challenge your faith life as well! This is an opportune time to kickstart your faith. If you are struggling with the mass and its significance, fear not. The National Eucharistic Revival is coming soon! Archbishop Schnurr is inviting ALL Catholics, through their parishes and schools, to grow in our understanding and devotion to the Eucharist. The Archbishop has provided for a great and easy way to help our students and faculty grow in meeting Christ in the Eucharist through a series of videos explaining the mass. This will be a six-week study beginning the week of Sunday, January 8 and concluding the week of Sunday, February 12. Our 6th thru 8th graders will be taking part in the program but using a different resource. The content of the study for adults will be the excellent video series "The Mass" from Bishop Robert Barron's Word on Fire Ministries. Each Sunday, the Archbishop will email all participants the 25-minute episode along with his own brief insights. Individuals can view the study at their own pace, on their own time, over the course of the week to invigorate their love for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. You may sign up to receive the emails at <u>https://catholicaoc.org/themass</u> This may be just what your family needs to recommit to attending mass. Students are bringing home postcards today with information about this important series.

COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

Students in second grade are beginning to learn to read and write in cursive. The teachers in second grade will begin by instructing students to use the correct posture and angle their bodies to be successful writers. Next, they will learn the four types of cursive strokes which include the under curve, over curve, down curve, and slant. The students will begin to write and use cursive the rest of the school year in second grade as they perfect their handwriting and learn to read cursive as well!

We have a few enrichment classes we are offering after school for the winter trimester. These include chess, coding and STEAM. A licensed teacher runs the programs that require students to apply their math and science skills, while having fun with their classmates. Check out the flyers attached to the newsletter to sign up!

Coding provides your child with ways to think critically to create games and control robots using twenty first century learning skills.
