We are just one week away from the holiest season of the liturgical year. Ash Wednesday is next week. It's a period of preparation prior to the Lord's Resurrection. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer,; we serve by [giving alms](#); and we practice self-control through [fasting](#). We are called to an inner conversion. Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and abstinence. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence means avoiding all meat.

During Lent our students will be praying the Stations of the Cross or the Divine Mercy Chaplet on Fridays.

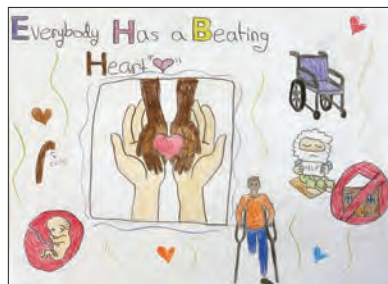
Each poster will be evaluated on its originality, use of medium, interpretation of theme and presentation of a pro-life message, and overall effect. Please no copyrighted material.
