Parent Alert: The Drug Enforcement Administration is advising the public of an alarming emerging trend of colorful fentanyl available across the United States. In August 2022, DEA and our law enforcement partners seized brightly-colored fentanyl and fentanyl pills in 18 states. Dubbed "rainbow fentanyl" in the media, this trend appears to be a new method used by drug cartels to sell highly addictive and potentially deadly fentanyl made to look like candy to children and young people. They are made to look like Skittles, Sweet-tarts or rock candy. Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid that is 50 times more potent than heroin and 100 times more potent than morphine. Just two milligrams of fentanyl, which is equal to 10-15 grains of table salt, is considered a lethal dose.

In my last Google follow-up search, it did not seem that "Rainbow Fentanyl" has been found in Hamilton County, but Fentanyl has. It's probably a good time to remind your children not to take candy from strangers unless parents are around to supervise it.

Schools receive safety alerts throughout the year to help keep us informed of potential threats. Alerts could be something like fentanyl, Covid, or security issues.

Speaking of safety, you may have noticed Green Township Police sitting in our parking lots. This is proactive behavior to help keep our schools safe. The police officers are watching traffic patterns and catching speeders. Officers will also walk through the building so that they are familiar with the floor plan. In addition, our school will undergo a "Vulnerability Assessment" to determine our greatest safety needs. If there are any incidents at school, I will send out a Rediker message with any details I can provide.

Don't forget to spend time with your family at mass this weekend. Even better, ask another family to join you for mass! Our parish times are 4:00 Saturday, 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. on Sunday morning.


