COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

Students in Mr. Day's science class have been working on using different tools to measure the length of objects around school in Metric (SI) and Imperial (Standard) units. The students were responsible for filling in the length of items using centimeters, millimeters, meters, inches, and feet. The conversion chart helped students see how each form of measurement differs based on their unit of measurement. The students enjoyed the opportunity to learn and work with partners!
