
This Sunday, Missalettes will return to the pews. Please help your child work through the Missalette and find the Sunday readings. This will help engage them with the Sunday readings.

COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

What's so special about STEM? Fifth graders are learning exactly what STEM education is all about to begin their unit on the Engineering Design Process. STEM uses Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics in an applied approach to solve problems, use creativity and think critically. STEM education instills a skill set that dictates the way students think and solve challenges presented in the classroom, and ultimately in the real world. Students are finding out that STEM is everywhere as they explore and research STEM careers. Students are excited to learn what a typical day looks like for marine biologists, 3-D designers, veterinarians, robotics engineers, web designers, urban planners, biomedical engineers and so many more! They will apply science, technology, engineering and mathematics in various STEM challenges that will push them to collaborate, problem solve and think outside the box throughout the year. *"Scientists discover the world that exists. Engineers create the world that never was."*

Students ages 5-7 can try the free app Scratchjr to work on or learn coding skills. This app allows children to program their own stories and games. Coding gives students the ability to work on higher level thinking skills needed to solve problems and think creatively outside the box. Check it out!
