AUG'S BLOG

Visitation Families,

This is a part of the Church Bulletin series called "Word and Worship". It is written by seminarian Jacob Schmiesing. It describes different parts of the mass. **Blessing of Deacon before the Gospel**: The priest's blessing of the deacon before the Gospel is based on Romans 10:8 which in turn references Deuteronomy 30:14. "May the Lord be in your heart and on your lips..." which is where Paul writes where the Word of Faith should be and where Deuteronomy states the commands of the Lord are found. The reference to "heart and lips" means that the Word of God should be deeply internalized (heart) and recited and spread (lips).

teachers are able to communicate more easily. We do NOT take it as a sign of disinterest if you choose not to schedule a conference. In grades 4-8, the teachers are limited in their time slots. The Cincinnati Western Baseball Conference (CWBC) is seeking umpires for the 2025 baseball season. The CWBC season runs from March 22, 2025 through the end of June. Umpire training classes are scheduled to be held on the Saturday mornings of February 22, March 1 and March 8 from 9:00am – 12:00pm at Our Lady of Victory cafeteria. On-field sessions are scheduled for March 14-16 at Our Lady of Visitation fields.

- Umpires must be at least a freshman in high school and have reliable transportation to and from games.
- No prior experience as an umpire is required, but a working knowledge of baseball is strongly recommended.
- New umpires are required to attend each of the three classroom sessions and at least one of the on-field sessions.
- Returning umpires are encouraged to attend the classroom sessions and the onfield sessions.
- The cost for the training is \$20 for new umpires. New umpires will be responsible for purchasing their umpire apparel and gear.
- Umpire fees will start at \$50 per game for the 2025 season.
