ED CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP

The State will be sending out a **Scholarship Acceptance Form** for each Visitation student who has been awarded a scholarship. These forms will be generated about a week after the scholarship has moved to "Awarded" in the EdChoice portal, and sent to parents **via mail**. My contact at EdChoice has said people are receiving the letters within two to three weeks after the application is changed to awarded status. Visitation families are beginning to be awarded in the State system and will start receiving these forms. Once you receive the form(s) please promptly complete the information requested and return the form(s) **to the Our Lady of the Visitation School office** as soon as possible. We will then process them promptly. We will let you know about tuition adjustments and refunds when we have more details from the State.

**Important – The scholarship cannot be granted until this form is returned to the school for each student. This is the documentation we need to approve the scholarship in the State system.*

Cash can be used for milk, snacks and ice cream. Assorted bagged snacks daily for \$.75. Ice cream for \$1.50. Milk and water for \$.50, may be purchased daily with cash or online.

To purchase the regular lunch or hot a la carte items, you must set up an account and order through https://olvlunch.ahotlunch.com/login. Lunches must be ordered by 8:00 a.m. daily. Regular lunch is \$4.00. Hot a la carte is \$2.00.

If your student has an appointment and will not be here for lunch, please do not order lunch for that day. If your student is sick or leaves early due to emergency or sickness, your account will be credited for that day's missed lunch. Please note, you can always go into your account and cancel any lunch up until 8:00am daily of the day ordered.

How it works:

- If you are unable to attend you may drop off packed shoeboxes (w/\$10 shipping) in the back of any church after Masses November 11th-12th.
- We will gladly accept monetary donations and/or items for the shoeboxes.


