COOK'S CURRICULUM CORNER

In the library, junior high students worked on a STEM activity known as a Marble Run. This activity required students to use critical thinking skills to design a maze considering lengths, angles, velocity, and acceleration to allow a marble to pass through an entire maze successfully.
