Tis the Season...Advent has begun! The season of Ordinary Time has ended in the church and we transition into a new liturgical year with hope and patience! Did you know our church has three cycles of readings? We will transition from Cycle C to Cycle A. In year A, we read mostly from the Gospel of Matthew on Sundays. Advent begins the new cycle of readings and the new liturgical year.

Report Cards will be emailed out today. We only print the final report cards. As a reminder, it takes our system many hours to send out 775 report cards. If you get one report card for your child but not another, just hold tight. If you don't receive a report card by Thursday afternoon, please contact the school office. Students were recognized at our Awards Assembly this morning.

Please continue to pray for some ill students, CeCe in kindergarten and Ross in 5th grade. Ross had surgery a few weeks ago and begins proton therapy this week. CeCe is preparing for a trip to Seattle in January to undergo treatment. She will eventually be out there for 8 weeks. Advent Service Project

Make At Home & Drop Off Event Sandwich & Snack Collection for Our Daily Bread Tuesday, Dec 6TH



Drop Off: 6:30-7:00 p.m.In front of Visitation Church

Make At Home and Drop Off Event- The sandwiches we make will be provided with every hot meal so that their guests can have something to eat later in the day or over the weekend.

Here are three ways you and your family can help:

1) Make Sandwiches at Home: (Please note NEW Instructions for Making Sandwiches at Home from ODB.)

Meat Sandwich Assembly Instructions: We usually only put bread and meat; cheese is a bonus, no condiments. Any type of bread or meat is accepted, but our guests tend to prefer white bread over wheat and turkey, ham, pepperoni/salami over bologna. Place each individual sandwich in a <u>zipper</u> sandwich bag and <u>mark or label</u> with the type of sandwich or label the box/container that you bring them in to Visitation. If you are able to bring them in a **box**, that will help keep sandwiches from being squished.

**Peanut Butter & Jelly Sandwiches- now accepted too! Please put a thin layer of peanut butter on each piece of bread and jelly or jam in the middle. (Protects bread longer from getting soggy.)

Family Goal: make 20-40 sandwiches with 2-3 slices of meat/ sandwich (2-4 loaves of bread, 1-2 pounds meat, ½ pound cheese, do not use the ends/butts of the loaf.)

2) Make Treats at Home or Donate Packaged Treats: (new option to make treats at home)

Instructions for donating treats: If making from scratch, separate into individual treats- place in plastic wrap or zip locked bags. If purchasing pre-packaged sweets, there is no need to remove them from packaging. **Treat examples:** Chocolate chip cookies, cookie bars, brownies, rice crispy treats, danishes, donuts, bear claws, muffins, Little Debbie snacks, cake balls, individual servings of pie or cake

3) OTHER ITEMS TO DONATE:

- Fruit-oranges and bananas (No apples or pears please, many of our guests struggle with eating these)
- Lunchables, tuna pouches, ravioli with meat, Dinty Moore/Chunky (soup/stew- pop tops only)
- Snack sized bagged chips
- Breakfast/Granola Bars
- Individual-size nuts or cracker packs
- Apple sauce or fruit cups
- Cases of Water or Kids Drinks





The donations will be delivered to our daily bread, Dec 7th in the morning so that they can be handed out during that afternoon's lunch.
