### **AUG'S BLOG**

Visitation Families.

Today is the feast day of St. Nicholas. Perhaps, you celebrated this German Catholic tradition by "hanging your stockings with care in hopes that St. Nicholas soon would be there". This tradition goes back to the story of how St. Nicholas came upon a poor father and his three unmarried daughters. There was no money for a dowry, which was expected for marriage, and so while the girls' stockings were hung by the fireplace to dry, Nicholas tossed gold coins through an open window which

landed into their stockings. This tradition tends to be stronger in families with German Catholic heritage.

Students in Grades 3-8 celebrated the sacrament of Reconciliation today. It is a great way to celebrate God's eternal love and forgiveness during Advent. As a reminder, students are asked to bring in loose change and dollars from their piggy banks to help support Catholics in the Holy Land. The change will be donated to the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, which is a philanthropy order that aids schools and currently provides relief for the Christians who are affected by the current war. Thank you to Mr. Bellman for coordinating. He went on a pilgrimage with this group this past summer.

Today we also held our Advent Prayer Service, focusing on the significance of the candles, wreath and light. Each day, we also have a student talk about a member of God's family and place an ornament on the Jesse Tree displayed in our main hallway.

Friday is the feast of the Immaculate Conception. Our students will attend the 8:30 a.m. mass on Friday. It is a holy day of obligation. This feast day is probably the most confusing of all feast days. This is the day we celebrate that Mary, the Virgin Mother, was born free of original sin. Mary was granted this unique privilege because of her role as the Mother of Jesus.

Next week, our students will have the opportunity to visit the Eucharistic Miracles of the World display created by Blessed Carlos Acutis. He was a Catholic Italian teenager who loved gaming, computers...and the Eucharist! He created this display of miracles of the world that revolve around the Eucharist before dying at the age of 15 from leukemia.

Thank you to our 3rd, 7th and 8th grades, our piano Enrichment students, Mrs. Neeley and Mr. Vasconcelos for two wonderful concerts last night to get us in the holiday spirit. Next week is our band concert.

Thursday is an Out of Uniform Day for students who sold at least one Buddy Card or a \$5 donation. Your child may still bring in a \$5 donation on Thursday if they have yet to do so. These funds go in our Development Fund. This includes promoting our school, decorations used in school, folders for new families, etc. Occasionally, it will buy our teachers a treat as well!

Next Tuesday, our 7th Grade Academic Team will compete against other local schools at Elder. Thanks to teacher Mrs. Kelhoffer who coordinates both 7th and 8th grade teams. They also have a spring competition held at LaSalle.

Lastly, I wanted to share a quote with you that I saw online and it continues to resonate with me. "Give your children social media when you want their childhood to end." Many of us educators worry about the mental health issues directly associated with the use of Smartphones. Often, children are exposed to adult topics/situations that their minds are not ready to process. It has truly become an issue with so many of our students. We, like parents, always worry about your children.

### **ED CHOICE SCHOLARSHIPS**

Check your mail! The State is sending out a Scholarship Acceptance Forms for each Visitation student who has been awarded a scholarship. These forms will be generated about a week after the scholarship has moved to "Awarded" in the EdChoice portal, and sent to parents via mail. My contact at EdChoice has said people are receiving the letters within two to three weeks after the application is changed to awarded status. Visitation families are beginning to be awarded in the State system and will start receiving these forms. Once you receive the form(s), please promptly complete the information requested and return the form(s) to the Our Lady of the Visitation School office as soon as possible. We will then process them promptly. We will let you know about tuition adjustments and refunds when we have more details from the State. \*\*Important – The scholarship cannot be granted until this form is returned to the school for each student. This is the documentation we need to approve the scholarship in the State system. \*Also, you can lose this scholarship if you are absent 20 or more days from school. 


